

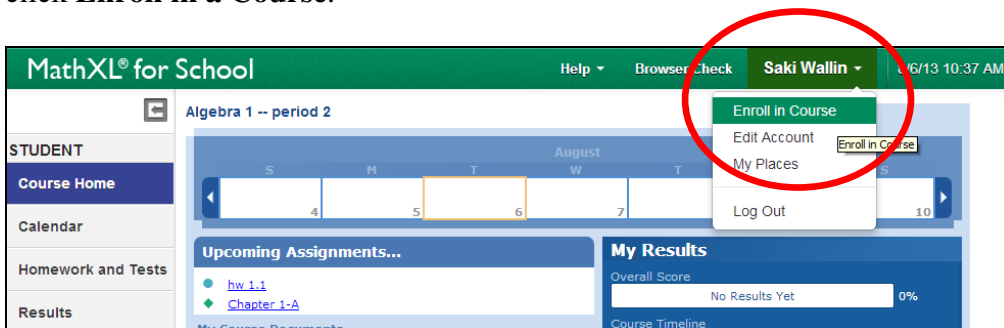
Students can move themselves from one MathXL for School course to another very easily.

If you enroll into one course or section and then need to switch to another, you can move yourself into the new course. When you move into the new course, your name is automatically removed from the previous course's roster and added to the new course roster.

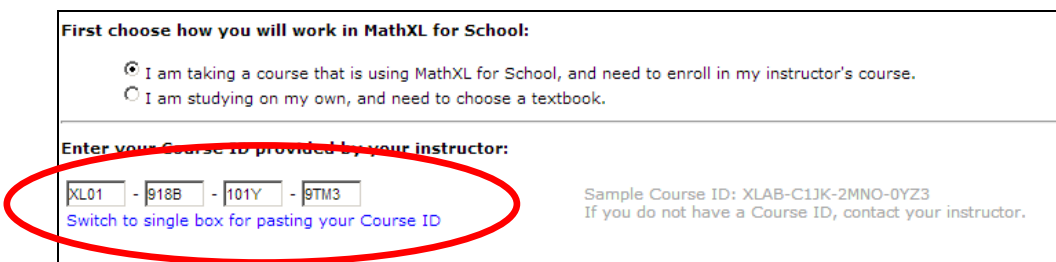
**Note:** If you need to be enrolled in two courses at the same time, follow these instructions instead: <http://info.mathxlforschool.com/two-course-enrollment>.

Students—follow the steps below to move from one course to another:

1. Ask your teacher for the Course ID for your new course.
2. Go to [www.mathxlforschool.com](http://www.mathxlforschool.com) and sign in to your student account.
3. From any page in your course, click on **your name** in the banner along the top of the screen, then click **Enroll in a Course**.



4. On the Enroll in a Course page, type in the Course ID for your new course. If your teacher emailed you the Course ID, click the link to switch to one large field for copying and pasting the ID into.



5. Confirm that the name of the course looks correct, then click **Enroll**.
