Then come together with students from around the world at our two-day leadership conference in Davos, Switzerland, where she will work on creative solutions to challenges that will prepare you for an ever-changing world driven by technology and globalization.

Highlights of the trip include a visit to Anne Frank's house and The Hague and the International Court of Justice in Amsterdam, the headquarters of UNESCO (a branch of the UN that uses education and international collaboration to promote peace and security) and a meeting with French high school students in Paris and to the United Nations Office in Geneva. And lastly she will experience the Global Leaders Summit in Dayos.

We are also very excited to announce that Saint Augustine High School students will be joining our OLP students on this incredible journey. Students from both schools will travel together to our three destinations and then on to the Summit in Davos. This is a great opportunity for the students from both schools to interact in an a very different recreational and educational setting.
